

DISPATCHING PROCEDURE:

Assets not removed within the prescribed dispatching period will be forfeited. The buyer will forfeit all rights on any or all lots not removed within the prescribed dispatching period to the seller, unless other arrangements are made and can be proved in writing by the purchaser and agreed to by the seller. Buyers are encouraged to remove their assets as soon as possible as Aucor will not take responsibility for any damage to assets purchased on auction.

- Buyers will do an online Induction before entering the site:

- Buyers who do not have an e-mail address will do a manual induction at reception.

Loading of loose assets:

- The mine will make a 5ton capacity forklift and a 30ton capacity crane available to assist buyers with loading. This will be at no cost to the buyer.

Loading of assets requiring a Crane bigger than 30ton capacity

- Buyers must make use of Concord Cranes (at the buyers own cost)

Loading of vehicles:

- Buyers must bring a rollback or trailer with a winch

Cutting:

- No cutting on site will be allowed

Truck pre-requisites:

- Trucks must be roadworthy
- Trucks must have stop blocks
- Trucks will be inspected by the mine (Trucks / Vehicles that are not roadworthy or in a bad condition, will not be allowed on the mine)
- Drivers must have valid licenses
